FIRE DETECTION & EXTINGUISHING — SCHEDULE II (summary)

- Fixed smoke/heat detection: 6 zones — Hochiki ESP system
- Fixed CO2 total flooding: engine room + cargo holds 1-3
- Portable extinguishers: 12x dry powder 9 kg + 12x CO2 5 kg
- Fire pumps: 2x electric (100 m3/h each) + 1x emergency diesel pump
- Fire suits: 4 complete sets (BA, helmet, gloves, boots, axe)
- International shore connection: fitted (port side, frame 22)
